ROLE OF MINISTRY OF ECONOMY AND DEVELOPMENT

Ensuring the implementation of the law on development policy, planning and its management, developing Mongolia's long-term, medium-term and short-term development policy documents to ensure national, interdisciplinary, sectoral, regional and local coordination, supporting population growth, ensuring human development, and social development and determine the integrated policy of high technology and national innovation system.

PROVIDING PLANNING METHODOLOGY AND GUIDELINES FOR SECTOR AND LOCAL AUTHORITIES

9.4.1.to organize the development policy and planning activities at state, sectoral, inter-sectoral, regional and local level with integration, and provide with consolidated methodology, management, and coordination;



**State administrative
authorities**

9.4.3.to directly manage macro-economic policy and development policy and planning matters in inter-sectoral level, and provide approval with respect to whether draft state budget consistent with the long-term development policy of Mongolia, Five-year development guideline of Mongolia and annual development plan of the state;



**Local administrative
authorities**

9.4.8.to train and building capacity of specialized and expert human resources of development policy and planning;



9.4.11.to determine direction to follow with regard to development policy and planning, and offer integrated management and specialized consultation for the preparation of development policy and planning documents;

ACTORS IN THE DEVELOPMENT PLANNING

Parliament – Approve the national development policy

Government of Mongolia

- Manage nationwide implementation of national development policy
- Draft of regulation on development policy and planning documents

Ministry of Finance:

- Link state and local budeting with development policy and planning

Ministries:

Participate in the development of policy formulation, planing, implementation, performance monitoring and reporting within it's authorities



- Audit the development policy and planning documents under ;
- Provide recommendation, conclusion together with the audit report of development policy and planning documents



- Audit the development policy and planning documents under;
- Provide recommendation, conclusion together with the audit report of development policy and planning documents



- Ensure macro-economic and financial sustainability in drafting, planning and implementation of the development policy and planning documents;
- Comment on development policy and planning activities;

WAY FORWARD

- In order to accelerate implementation of the SDGs ensure effective cooperation between all level of government (horizontally and vertically, from the national level to the local level)
- Cross-sectoral monitoring mechanism need to improve the national institutions for the monitoring, evaluation and reporting of the implementation of the SDGs, establish a results monitoring mechanism and align it with the accountability system.
- Clarify the legal regulation, responsibilities of stakeholders related to spatial development planning and regional economic development, as well as the financing system
- Ensure the participation of citizens and public in the implementation of the SDGs, and by supporting their initiatives and efforts, to make participatory development processes and decision-making a social culture
