Charlie Project: Including the Vulnerable Groups in Policy Making

- 1) **Planning** : Find Charlies: young women in poverty (chosen according to application essay <THE GOLDEN TICKET>, asserting their passion to make social change)
 -
 - 2) **Implementing**:
 - Policy-making suggested by Charlies while working with government officials
- (Policies cover a variety of themes, ranging from renewable energy, everyday problems, changes that they deem necessary in their lives)
- Qualitative research constructed by Charlies (accurate, timely recognition about charlie community)
- 3) **Adjusting**: Monitoring and evaluating what changes Charlies have made

Expected Results

- Reduce the digital divide: giving accessibility and accelerating digital transformation
- Educate young vulnerable women
- Reduce climate change: environmental changes accelerating, impacting vulnerable groups
- Start with young women -> affect the whole society (bring change in developing countries)
- Ultimately, it will include inclusion of ALL vulnerable groups → empowering ABILITY, OPPORTUNITY, DIGNITY → SOCIAL INCLUSION!!!!
